

Application for Parking Fee Waiver at Merimbula Airport - Aircraft in Maintenance



Aircraft Parking Charges

Bega Valley Shire Council charges a daily parking fee for all aircraft parked at Merimbula Airport in excess of seven (7) consecutive days. Aircraft parked at Merimbula Airport for a period less than seven (7) consecutive days are exempted from the daily parking fee. The daily parking fee is determined each financial year and is listed in Council's adopted Fees and Charges, which can be found at www.begavalley.nsw.gov.au.

Applying for a Parking Fee Exemption

Aircraft owners may apply to Bega Valley Shire Council for a waiver of aircraft parking fees listed in Council's adopted Fees and Charges when an aircraft is in maintenance for a nominated period of up to three (3) months. The application must be made prior to or at the beginning of the maintenance period by completing the attached form, Application for Parking Fee Waiver at Merimbula Airport – Aircraft in Maintenance.

Conditions of Parking Fee Waiver when an Aircraft is in Maintenance

In applying for this aircraft parking fee waiver at Merimbula Airport when an aircraft is in maintenance, the Applicant:

1. acknowledges they must apply for a parking fee waiver prior to or at the beginning of the maintenance period. Parking fees will not be waived retrospectively if an Application for Parking Fee Waiver at Merimbula Airport – Aircraft in Maintenance form has not been completed prior to or at the beginning of the maintenance period.
2. acknowledges they will notify the Airport Manager directly in writing when aircraft maintenance is complete and aircraft parking fees should recommence.
3. acknowledges that the Airport Manager and/or Council will routinely verify details of aircraft in maintenance in consultation with the maintenance provider. Any Application received fraudulently will be terminated immediately and the daily parking fees invoiced.
4. acknowledges if an aircraft is parked at Merimbula Airport and is in long term maintenance for a period in excess of three (3) months, the Applicant may reapply for an aircraft parking fee waiver, however ongoing approval is at the discretion of Bega Valley Shire Council.
5. acknowledges they are required to hold appropriate levels of insurance for their aircraft.
6. acknowledges they are parking an aircraft at Merimbula Airport at their own risk and the Airport Manager and Bega Valley Shire Council will not accept liability for any accidents, damage or loss incurred.
7. confirms they have read, understood and must comply with these conditions.
