5. Definition of liquid trade waste

IMPORTANT - Read the following information before proceeding with the application.

The Local Government (General) Regulation, 2005 defines "trade waste" as all liquid waste other than sewage of a domestic nature.

Section 3 of the Local Government (General) Regulation, 2005 contains the following definition:

"sewage of a domestic nature includes human faecal matter and urine and waste water associated with ordinary kitchen, laundry and ablution activities of a household, but does not include waste in or from a sewage management facility."

To explicitly differentiate trade waste as defined above from the other wastes also generated by industry and commerce the term liquid trade waste is now generally used by regulatory authorities. For the purpose of this application the term "liquid trade waste" is considered to have the same definition as "trade waste"

NB. While stormwater and unpolluted water are **not** considered as liquid trade waste they are still **not** allowed to be discharged to Council sewer without approval.

Additional points to note regarding what constitutes liquid trade waste:

- Community/public premises such as craft clubs, schools and hospitals also require Council approval to discharge liquid trade waste to sewer.
- The toilet, hand basin and shower wastes derived from business, commercial, community/public or industrial premises are **not** considered to be liquid trade waste.
- Business, commercial, trade community/public or industrial activities conducted at premises other than that of the provider (e.g. mobile carpet cleaner, graffiti removalist) will also require Council approval for the discharge of any liquid trade waste to sewer.
- Septic tank waste (which is not commingled with liquid trade waste), waste from marine pump out facilities and the contents from a pan (e.g. toilets from mobile homes/caravans and portable toilets), cesspool or privy are **not** considered to be liquid trade waste. Council approval for the discharge to sewer of such wastes is still however required, but is managed separately to liquid trade waste.
- Where liquid trade waste is discharged to a septic tank or other receptacle on a premises, which is then pumped out and the contents transferred to a Council sewerage treatment plant, an approval to discharge liquid trade waste to sewer is required.
- Commercial activities conducted at a domestic /residential dwelling will require Council approval for the discharge to sewer of any liquid trade waste generated.
- While the discharge from a commercial/community/public swimming pool backwash operation is considered to be liquid trade waste, the same discharge from domestic/residential swimming pools is **not** classified as such.
- Liquid discharges from individual caravan park site kitchen facilities and common laundry facilities are not considered to be liquid trade
 waste.
- Liquid trade waste can also originate from stables and kennels not associated with domestic households, saleyards, racecourses, market places, washing areas and agricultural enterprises (e.g. piggeries dairies, cattle sheds).

6. Substances prohibited from being discharged to the sewerage system

It is **important** that you read and understand this section as discharging prohibited substances to the sewerage system, other than in accordance with a liquid trade waste approval is an offence.

The following substances **shall** not be included in the liquid trade waste:

- (a) Organochlorine weedicides, fungicides, pesticides and substances of similar nature and/or wastes arising from the preparation of these substances;
- (b) Organophosphorus pesticides and/or waste arising from the preparation of these substances;
- (c) any substance liable to produce noxious or poisonous vapours in the sewerage system;
- (d) organic solvents or mineral oils;
- (e) any flammable or explosive substances;
- (f) discharges from 'Bulk Fuel Depots';
- (g) chromate from cooling towers;
- (h) natural or synthetic resins, plastic monomers, synthetic adhesives and rubber or plastic emulsions;
- (i) rain, surface, seepage of subsoil water, unless specifically permitted;
- (j) solid matter;
- (k) any substance assessed as not suitable to be discharged to the sewerage system;
- (l) waste liquids that contain pollutants at concentrations which inhibit the sewage treatment processes refer National Wastewater source Management Guidelines, July 2008, WSAA;
- (m) any other substances listed in a relevant regulation.
