6. New Business

6.1 Hall Committee Sharing ideas

Cobargo Hall

Cobargo is a service town where many people visit. During the week stacked bookings on most days. Council has used the hall for fire recovery outreach and library for programs and Cobargo committees such as writing workshops, sewing, CWA, yoga and meditation. Also, one on one consultations such as art therapy and naturopathy. Works well because the supper room can be hired as a separate space for smaller meetings. Hall Committee did some work to improve the look of the hall. Difficult to encourage younger people to join the hall committees.

Murrah Hall

Murrah Hall is a well-known music venue that was awarded a cultural grant via South East Arts for lighting bars and sound equipment. Hall Committee need to be responsible for the upkeep of this type of equipment and know how it all works. Good to have cultural infrastructure. House professionals that can

be hired for events by the band. Music venues in city are becoming less available and shows/music are going on the road. Good opportunity.

Action: Katrina Berenguer to invite a member of the Communications team to come to the next meeting to discuss: -

- encouraging new hall committee members to join in September; and
- upgrading BVSC venue hire website pages to make it easier for the public to hire the halls.

Action: All hall committees to review their hall BVSC website page and come to next meeting with ideas on updating the current information.

6.2 Neighbourhood Safer Places – Marty Webster - Far South Coast RFS

Neighbourhood Safer Place (NSP) is a place that has been assessed by the RFS as a place of last resort not a place to gather in an emergency. It is the bottom line if all the rest of your contingency planning has gone wrong. No facilities are provided and most designated NSP are open places.

Brogo Hall is the only building that has been designated an NSP. In the event of elevated fire danger, Police have an MOU to open the facility.

Action: Council to fine tune procedure with Marty Webster from Far South Coast RFS regarding opening Brogo Hall in the event of elevated fire danger.

It was suggested that signage will eventually need to be replaced by RFS as a place of last resort. Additional signage may be required to the designated open space. Signage changes need to be coordinated with RFS.

The designated NSP areas have safety audits conducted around September of each year.

Nethercote – There is no NSP identified in Nethercote, looking at private property but not a formal arrangement.

Towamba Hall – Peppermint trees around Showground that need removing. Marty Webster offered to conduct a safety audit with Dave Gatrell from the Hall Committee. RFS also agreed to replace fire hose that went missing in the 2019 fire event.

Tanja Hall – NSP is open space between back of school and hall. Slashing done on adjoining property.

6.3 Fire Safety Compliance Update

Due to the New South Wales Government introducing a series of new reforms to fire safety regulation and certification a stricter level of compliance is now required to obtain the necessary Annual fire safety statement. Over the past few years, the fire safety compliance levels have not been adequate which has resulted in some additional works required and increases in costs.

We have identified the following costs in this financial year <u>not to be paid</u> from the hall accounts to assist in managing these costs.
