Sustainability	To live within the limits of what the environment can provide, understanding the many interconnections between the economy society and the environment.
Ecological Sustainable Development (ESD)	ESD is defined as development that uses, conserves and enhances our natural resources so that ecological processes, and in turn the quality of life now and into the future, can be maintained.

1.4.1 Policy Statement

- engage with the community to improve the environmental and public health of the shire.


1.4.1.1 Elected Council

Ensure an environmental and public health policy is in place.


1.4.1.2 Environmental Health Coordinator
