4.1. Risk Management and Workplace Health & Safety for Committees

All community halls have a NSW Government COVID 19 Safety Plan dated 1 July 2020. A copy of the hall hire booking form with the current COVID 19 Community Hall Safety Plan is enclosed.

Hall hirers need to take full responsibility for implementing the COVID 19 safety plan including hand sanitiser on arrival, before and after cleaning areas of use, adhering to maximum numbers, social distancing and keeping a contact register of people attending the hall.

The halls are open for hire with COVID 19 restrictions in place and many regular hirers are returning.

The hall closure signage that was placed on the front entrance of the halls can be removed.

Sam Martin reported that the signage at Candelo Hall was screwed into the front door and will need to be repaired. He asked if this feedback can be provided to the Council team that installed the signage.

5.4 Capital Works - Special Variation (SV) Funding

Capital works funding has been allocated by Council via a special rate variation for the maintenance of Council buildings across the Shire. The projects below have been identified via the 2019 MBM Building Assessment Reports and will need to be delivered in FY2021.

6. Other Business

6.1 QR Codes

Sue Horton from Eden Log Cabin would like Council to consider QR Codes on community halls signage linked to the BVSC hall site page. It was identified that it would be a great way for the community to have

the full information they require about hiring the hall. The Learning Centre and Pools are currently using QR codes.

Action: Katrina Berenguer to investigate how to implement QR codes for the community halls and report back to the hall committee with information.

6.2 Kigh and Wandella Hall Rebuild

Council have agreed to proceed with purchasing the Kiah church land next door to the hall as the new site for the hall rebuild as it is a more suitable location.

Donations have also been collected by Friends of Kiah Hall which will be added to the Kiah Hall rebuild.

Recovery, Resilience and Rebuild are investigating funding for new toilets for the Kiah pavilion and the small shed next to the tennis courts that will hold sports equipment.

Gemma Gill from Recovery, Resilience and Rebuild is the Project Manager for each hall rebuild and will be commencing the community consultation and roadshow with Architect, Tim Lee to gather community feedback on the rebuild for both locations.

Meetings will take place on site with a trailer that opens with screens and computers. This is also an opportunity for the community to look at personal housing rebuilds.

The halls are community assets and the community should be involved in the rebuild designs. The halls will be built to last the next 100 years and will need to be delivered within the allocated budget.

Action: Katrina Berenguer to advise hall committee when the roadshow/community consultation is scheduled at Kiah and Wandella.

Katrina Berenguer acknowledged the Rotary Club of Merimbula for the installation of the new Kiah Pavilion and the repair work conducted at Wandella which included new installation of water tank to the composting toilet and repair of the shelter and BBQ area. Kiah hall donated their old BBQ to Wandella. They have been fantastic to work with and we are very thankful for their efforts to those local communities.

It was agreed to pass a motion of sincere thanks on behalf of the hall committee for their hard work and dedication. All committee members agreed.

Action: Katrina Berenguer to organise a letter of appreciation on behalf of the Hall Committee to the Rotary Club of Merimbula to be signed by Cr Robyn Bain.

Financial Statements FY2020

All hall committees should have received their full year financial statement from 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020. It was noted that four halls are in arrears: -

- Kiah
- Murrah
- Nethercote, and
- Quaama.

David Karonidis from Quaama Hall reported that it was hard to improve the financial situation of Quaama Hall with the Bushfire Relief Centre still in operation at the hall.

The Bushfire Relief Centre has paid a hall hire fee, but it has not been deposited into hall account.

Recovery, Resilience and Recovery are managing the issue of trying to relocate the Relief Centre and are planning a community consultation session at Quaama to better understand the community needs.
