Airport trees

Minor delays can be expected over the weekend while eight trees are removed from the Merimbula airport, the work in the airport carpark will start today (Friday, March 6) and end on Sunday March 8. Road control measures will be in place today when branches overhanging Arthur Kaine Drive are removed. Merimbula wall rocks

Works on the new rock wall along Beach Street in Merimbula will include a ramp suitable for wheelchair access from the new path to the water; an extended set of steps that will double as terrace seating right to the lake edge; a new lakeside pathway, landscaped parkland and park furniture. The existing fitness stations may need to be removed and reinstalled
